## To the leader: with stringed instruments. A Psalm of David.

- <sup>1</sup> Answer me when I call, O God of my right! You gave me room when I was in distress. Be gracious to me, and hear my prayer.
- <sup>2</sup> How long, you people, shall my honor suffer shame? How long will you love vain words, and seek after lies? *Selah*
- <sup>3</sup> But know that the LORD has set apart the faithful for himself; the LORD hears when I call to him.
- <sup>4</sup> When you are disturbed, do not sin; ponder it on your beds, and be silent. *Selah*
- <sup>5</sup> Offer right sacrifices, and put your trust in the LORD.
- <sup>6</sup> There are many who say, "O that we might see some good! Let the light of your face shine on us, O LORD!"
- <sup>7</sup>You have put gladness in my heart more than when their grain and wine abound.
- <sup>8</sup> I will both lie down and sleep in peace; for you alone, O LORD, make me lie down in safety.
